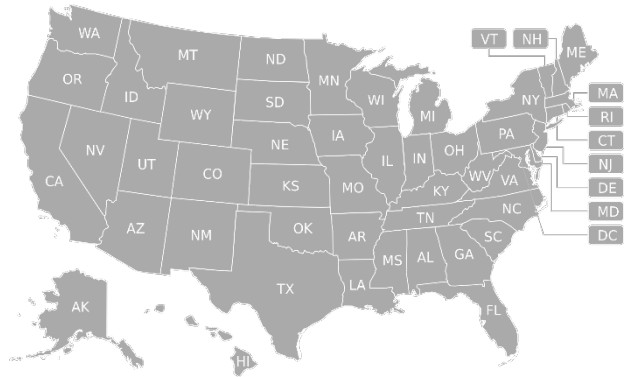


Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) Websites by State
